The psychiatry section of the Capital Region of Denmark (Region Hovedstadens Psykiatri) and the psychiatry section of the Region of Southern Denmark (Psykiatrien i Region Syddanmark) hereby put up a contract for tender for the development and, potentially, supply of new psychiatry beds in the Regions.

The object of the Central Region of Denmark and the Region of Southern Denmark (in the following the Contracting Entity) is, based on the Contracting Entity's draft design and technical specifications (which will form part of the tender documents), to complete the design and development of a psychiatry bed that, subsequently, can be put into production and supplied to the Contracting Entity with a high degree of security in terms of supply. The intention is to have developed a bed of a high quality which, in an optimal and innovative way, supports destigmatisation, self-reliance for the patient, security, hygiene and efficient working procedures. The aim is that the first beds can be supplied in May 2015.
